

### Women Economic Justice and Empowerment Programmes

- 709 women provided with start-up grant/equipment on the project
- 1,873 women trained on like skills Income Generating Activities (IGA) through the project
- 663 Women received financial assistance/start-up equipment for business



## Women Political Participation and Leadership

- **6,432** women reach through sensitization on political participation
- **10,536** women mobilized and supported to get voter's card during voter's registration exercises
- 154 women inducted into traditional council/cabinet



### Women's Peer Education Program

- 16 Peer Education Group established
- **130** women enrolled in Peer Education
- 211 (Male 138, Female 73) Traditional Leaders and Religious Leaders Reached
- 982 adolescent girls mentored on leadership and communication skills
