

# KEY RESULTS & ACHIEVEMENTS ACROSS INTERVENTION AREAS

15 partners (3 LWROs and 12 CBOs) currently demonstrate capacity to implement women's rights and feminist interventions in Cross River State.



## Addressing Gender-Based Violence/Violence Against Women and Girls

- **365** number of GBV related cases managed.
- 134 survivors provided with economic empowerment via skills and grants.
- 8 cased filed in court, 4 cases won.
- 177,911 women and girls reach through sensitization on GBV prevention and response.
- 1 Shelter set up to serve as a safe space for survivors that need safety.
- Development of GBV messaging guidelines for Christian and Islamic faith using their holy books to mainstream GBV message to their sermons.
- Formation of CSO-GBV COVID-19 Working Group who promoted awareness creation interventions on GBV through bulk SMS and massive media outreach in 3 radio stations and 2 TV stations across cross river and Akwa Ibom State. Over 1,000,000 persons were reached.



### Women Economic Justice and Empowerment Programmes

- 2,489 women trained on income generating skills.
- Through collaboration, **25** cooperative groups were trained and registered with the Nigerian Export Promotion Council (NEPC), giving them a competitive advantage and positioning them for business expansion and increased profits, via exportation.
- 2,298 women established/reactivated and still managing their business.
- 1,029 persons reached with awareness creation information on wrongful and indiscriminate taxation on businesses.
- Through collaborations with the government and other tax agencies, taxation has been reduced and monitored in marketplaces in Calabar Municipal Council Area, Bekwarra and Bakassi LGAs.
- 30 female petty traders equipped with the necessary financial literacy and business management.
  26 out of them, qualified and received grants of N50,000 each from the Federal Government to improve their businesses.

### Women Political Participation and Leadership

- 12 women secured political appointments with verifiable attribution to the WVL-Nigeria project related interventions via advocacy and policy influencing between 2020 and 2024.
- 21 women contested and won political seats at State/LGA levels with verifiable attributions to WVL-Nigeria project related interventions.
- 17 women inducted into traditional council/cabinets through advocacy actions attributed to the WVL-Nigeria project.
- 3,690 women collected their Permanent Voters' Cards (PVCs) through partners' combined advocacies and sensitization activities encouraging women's effective participation and increase of women voter turnout during the March 2023 elections.
- 17 young women mentored on elective leadership skills, won elections in their respective tertiary institutions of learning including the first female Student Union President of the University of Calabar (UNICAL).
