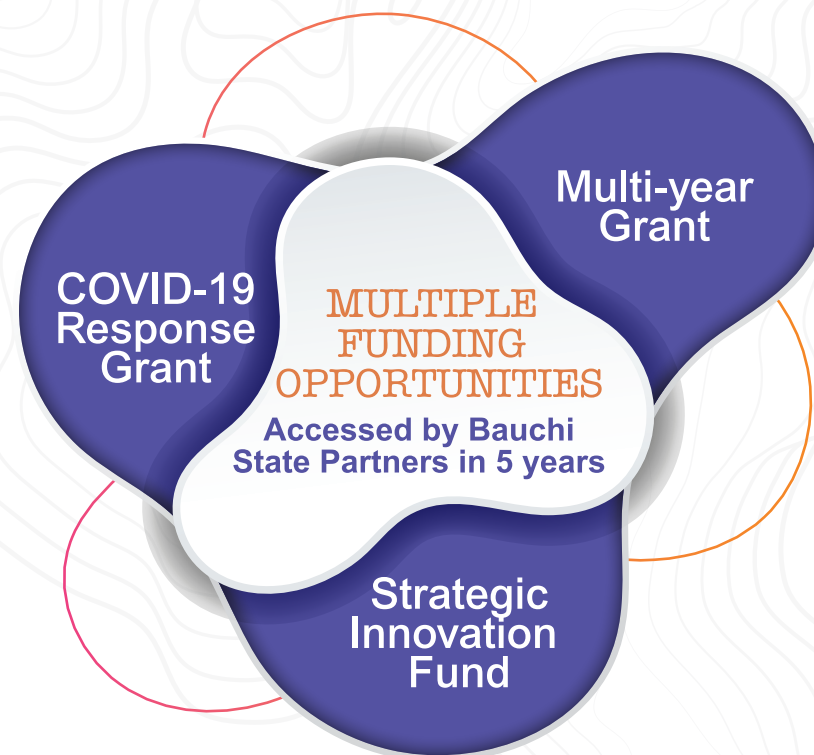

16 Partners currently demonstrate capacity to implement women's rights and feminist interventions in Bauchi State.



Addressing Gender Based Violence/Violence Against Women and Girls

- 21,253 women reached through sensitization on GBV prevention and response
- 78 GBV court cases handled
- 51 GBV court cases won
- 5 safe shelters in the state supported by the WVL project
- 11 GBV clubs established
- 799 GBV cases managed
- 29 GBV survivors provided with economic empowerment



Women Political Participation and Leadership

- 6 policies influenced/initiated in the state through the WVL project
- 7 women secured political appointment in the state through the implementation of the WVL project
- 24 peer education groups formed
- 576 women enrolled in peer education programme
- 11,444 women reached through sensitization on political participation
- 20 women supported during voter's registration exercises
- 12 women contested for political position through the WVL-N project support
- 7 women gained political appointment through the WVL-N project support
- 6,066 adolescent girls mentored on leadership and communication skills
- 1,937 Traditional Leaders and Religious Leaders reached
- 15 women inducted into traditional council/cabinet
- 143 women established/own a live skill business



Policy Influenced in the State

Advocated and campaigned to various key state stakeholders in Bauchi State for the passage of the VAPP Bill and Child Right Act into law in 2020.



Women Economic Justice and Empowerment Programmes

- 3,875 women and girl benefited from either cash or in-kind distribution
- 51,707 women reached
- 3,863 school children reached
- 20,444 men reached
- 365 structures formed and established
- 24,938 women reached through sensitization on economic empowerment
- 13 women provided with start-up grant/equipment on the project
